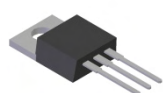

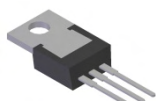

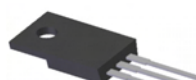
TO-220AB
Top View



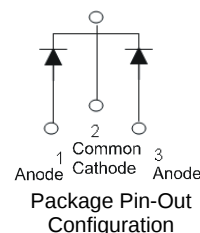
TO-220AB

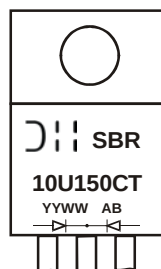

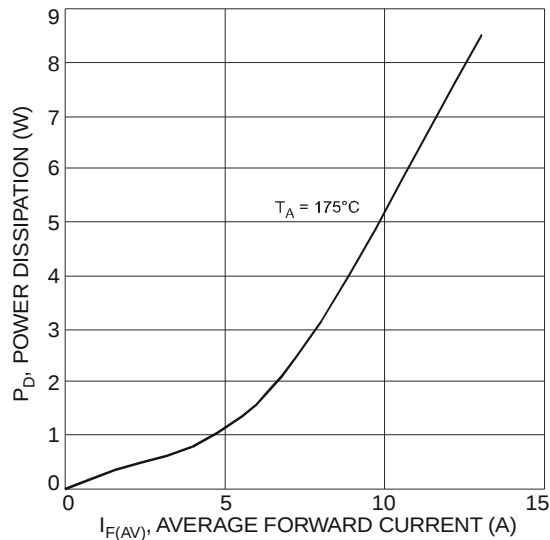


Fig. 1 Forward Power Dissipation

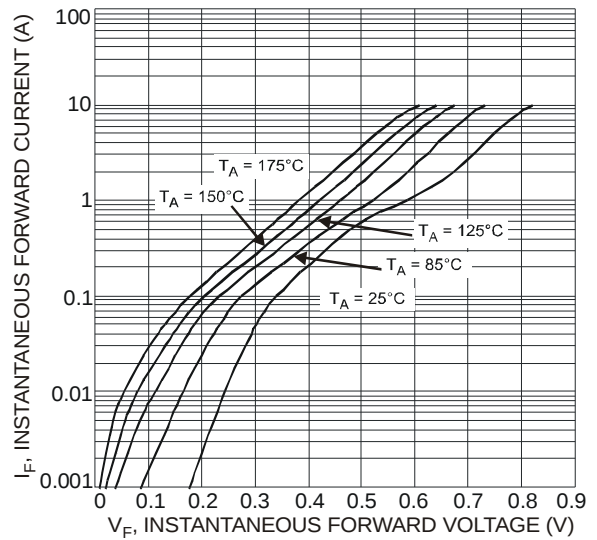


Fig. 2 Typical Forward Characteristics

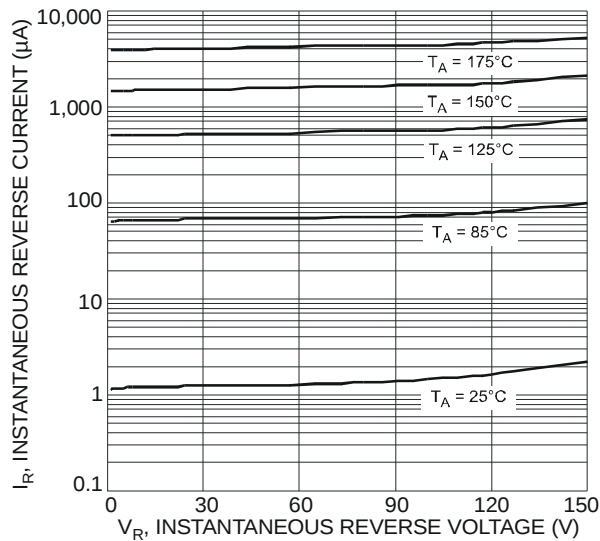


Fig. 3 Typical Reverse Characteristics

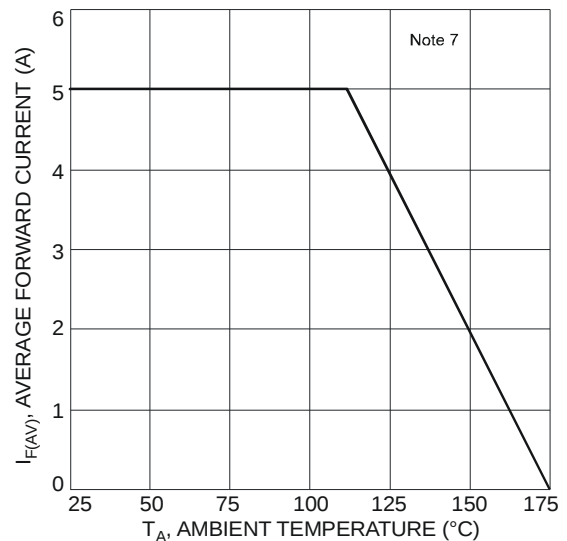


Fig. 4 Forward Current Derating Curve

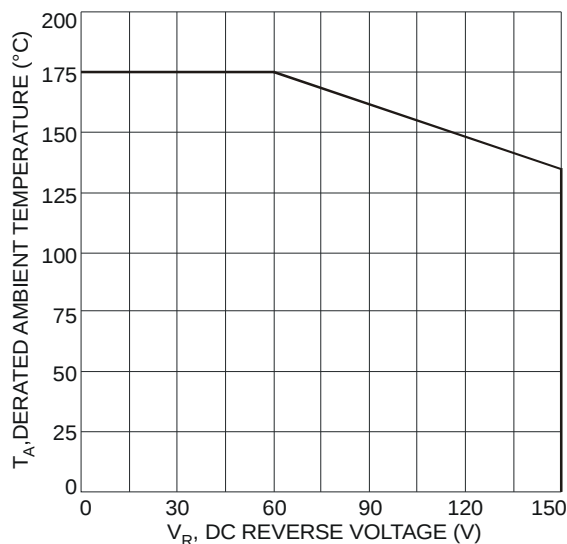
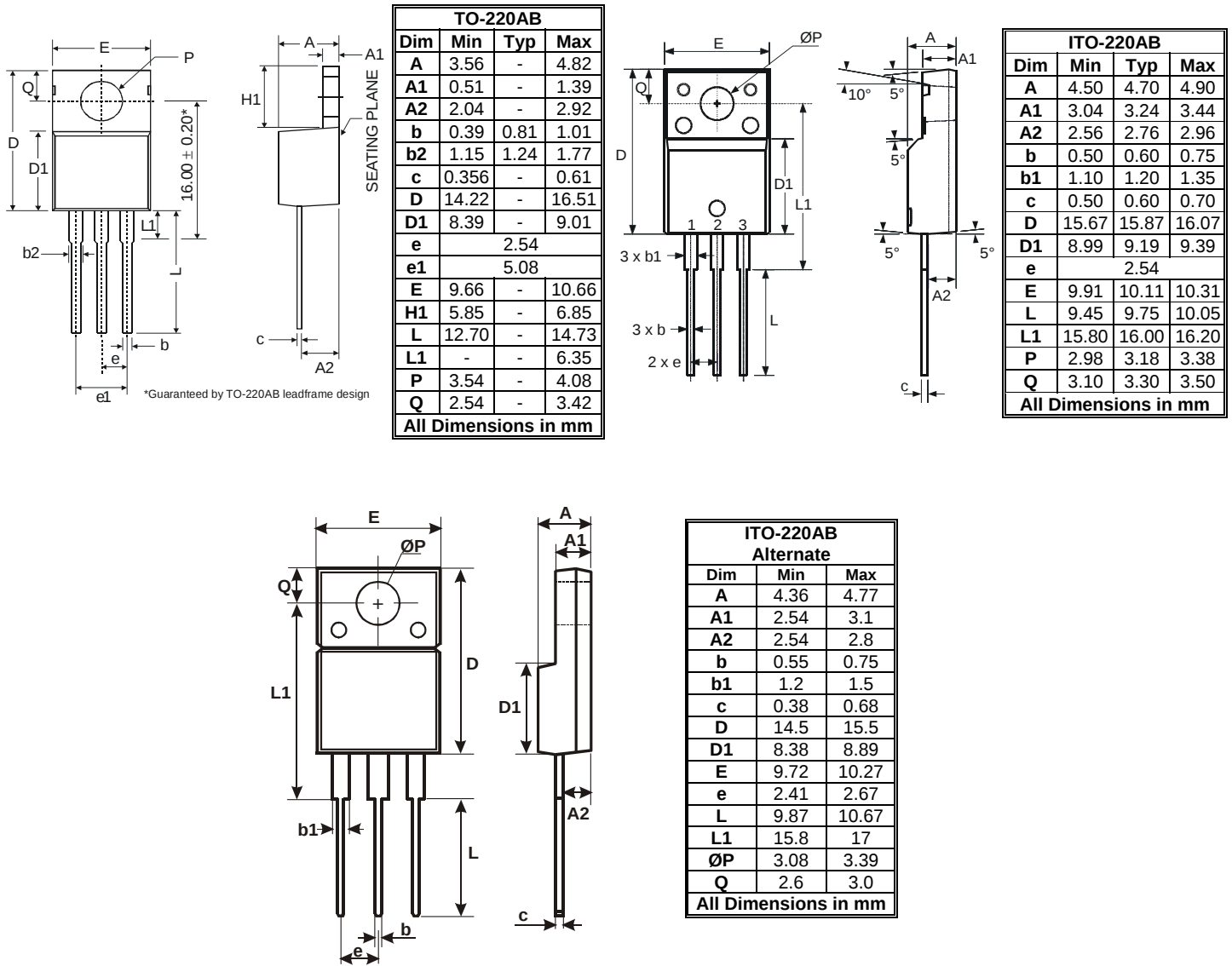


Fig. 5 Operating Temperature Derating
