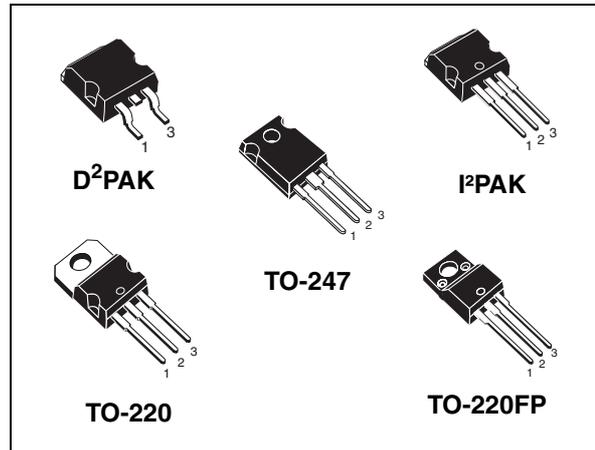


Figure 1. Internal schematic diagram

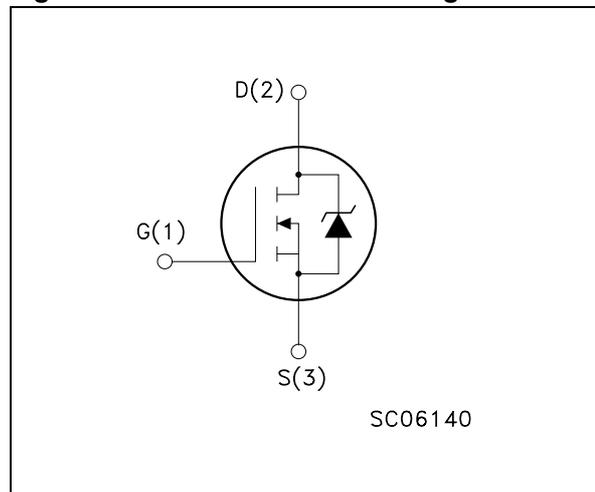

Figure 2. Safe operating area for TO-220 / D²PAK / I²PAK




Figure 3. Thermal impedance for TO-220 / D²PAK / I²PAK




Figure 4. Safe operating area for TO-220FP




Figure 5. Thermal impedance for TO-220FP




Figure 6. Safe operating area for TO-247




Figure 7. Thermal impedance for TO-247




Figure 8. Output characteristics




Figure 9. Transfer characteristics




Figure 10. Transconductance




Figure 11. Static drain-source on resistance




Figure 12. Gate charge vs gate-source voltage




Figure 13. Capacitance variations




Figure 14. Normalized gate threshold voltage vs temperature




Figure 15. Normalized on resistance vs temperature




Figure 16. Source-drain diode forward characteristics





Figure 17. Normalized B_{VDSS} vs temperature

Figure 18. Switching times test circuit for resistive load




Figure 19. Gate charge test circuit




Figure 20. Test circuit for inductive load switching and diode recovery times




Figure 21. Unclamped Inductive load test circuit




Figure 22. Unclamped inductive waveform





Figure 23. Switching time waveform


